Schedules

Schedules may be downloaded from the Washington Youth Soccer website by the individual who originally created the 2009-2010 application for the State League. If you are unsure who this individual is, email your team name, gender and age group, league division and team ID number to Hillary@wsysa.com

Follow these steps to access your league schedules and to manage your team scores:

- Go to www.wsysa.com
- Click on "League" which you will find at the top right of the web page.
- Download and READ the Team Managers Guide before attempting to login to the schedule and scores program.
- After reading the Team Managers Guide, you will need to log in at the member log in order to manage your schedules and scores. You will find the "Member Login" link on the League webpage. You will need to have your username and password to your member account in order to log in. Your user name and password is the same as what you created to submit your team application to the State League. If you have forgotten your user name and password you may use the "I forgot my information" button found on the member login screen and your user name and password will be emailed to you.
- The "Home" team will be responsible for entering the game scores and game time and location.
- To reschedule a game BOTH teams must agree in writing (email is acceptable). Once both teams are in agreement, the home team will simply change the game date on the schedule and click the update button.

Coaches and Player Membership Passes.

- Washington Youth Soccer State League teams are required, prior to the start of the game, to present the referee their team membership passes. Please contact your association registrar to obtain your membership passes. More information may be found in the rules and guidebook.

Responsibilities of Coaches/Managers

The home team's association is responsible for assigning their team a home field and home game time as well as assigning referees. Teams must contact their association for more information.

The following are the responsibilities of the "Home Team"

- Marking the field of play
- Providing a proper game ball
- Providing nets and corner flags
- Providing adequate and ACCURATE directions to the opposing team to the "home teams" venue NO LESS THAN seventy-two (72) hours prior to the game and no later than 9:00pm Wednesday night before the game.

Visiting teams MUST confirm receipt of the above "directions" by no later than 9:00pm Thursday night before the game. Please see rules and guidebook for more information.

Score Reporting

The home team must enter both the home and away teams game score into the online schedule and scores program by 9:00pm game day. See the team manager's guide for instructions on how to enter scores.
